**9.00am** Depart Rotorua for Auckland via Waitomo Caves

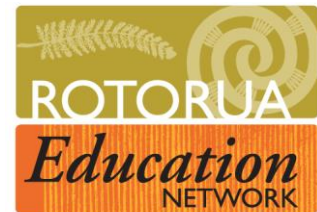
**11.00am Waitomo Glowworm Tour**

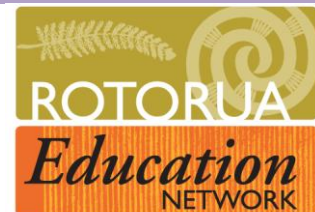
